Grand Tour Walking Art is an art research grant & residence to develop a project related to walking as an artistic practice. The winning artist or group of artists will work on a project of Walking Art in any form: sound art, action art, artistic tracks, public art, land art, audiovisual creation, proposals for walkers, etc.

The project will be presented at the Grand Tour 2016 between August 20th and September 4th 2016 in Catalonia, Spain

Characteristics

- * The residence is offered free of fees for a maximum of 4 artists of the same group.
- * Residence in Nau Còclea is not obligatory for the grant.
- * Duration of residence: minimum 15 maximum 30 days. Period to choose for the residence: any time between May and July 2016.
- * The project must be implemented during the walking journey Grand Tour 2016 in any point (northern regions of Girona, Roussillon and the Eastern Pyrenees).
- * The project's feasibility, simplicity and lightness will be evaluated positively, as well as the strategies encouraging the participation of walkers and the specific design of a project for walk and walking people.
- * Endowment of production aid is € 1000. This allocation includes the implementation of the proposal in Grand Tour 2016 for which there will not be more funding from our part.
- * The amount of the subsidy will be received as follows: 50% at the time of delivery of the grant and 50% after performance and presentation of invoice.

Submission of applications

- * Applications can be submitted until March 20th. 2016
- * Artists who wish to apply should send an email to resident@naucoclea.com attaching one document, labeled with the name of the project manager including:
 1. Contact of the project manager.
 2. Dates for residency (if you want to reside at Nau Còclea) with alternative options (if any). If you do not want to reside it should be explicitly stated.
 3. A description of the project (maximum 3 sheets with maximum 3 photos in jpg format and Internet links: web, blog, Youtube, Vimeo, etc.).
 6. A brief CV (maximum 1 page) Proposals sent by post will not be accepted.

Jury and resolution

The jury will be composed of:

Jordi Lafon, visual artist, walker

Jordi Puig, photographer, visual artist, walker

Clara Garí director of Nau Còclea, artist and walker

Carmen Sais, director of Bòlit Contemporary Art Centre of Girona, walker

The jury will select a winning artist and two finalists.

The three finalists will be announced on 10 April 2016. The decision will be communicated to the finalists and will be published in the website of Nau Còchlea and in other partner websites (Xarter, Xarxaprod, etc.)

The winner among the three finalists will be announced in Girona on April 17 during a party in the framework of the International Day of Art.

The application for this grant implies acceptance of the rules.
