The Contemporary Art Center Nau Côlea in Camallera Catalonia opens call for residences for 2020 We invite artists and researchers to apply for a residency of a minimum duration of 7 days and a maximum of 90

Available periods and artistic disciplines

The residence is offered from **March 2nd to June 14th and from October 5th to December 20th, 2020**. Applications are open to visual arts, live art, dance, sound art, music and writing projects. Essay writing projects on creation are also eligible.

Accommodation and resources

Accommodation is located in Camallera, Catalunya in a natural environment. The residency includes the accommodation of the artists (up to 4 people) in an independent house, the use of a 60m² workspace to share with the center, and outdoor spaces.

The house is made entirely available to the artist or group of selected artists. The artists are free to come with families and to invite whoever they wish by paying the corresponding fee (regarding the rate, see below).

The house is small. It has two double bedrooms, gas kitchen with double hot plate, microwave and small fridge, bathroom / shower and a living room with a wood stove. Central heating is also available. The use of the wood stove is free. The use of heating costs € 50 per week (minimum one week). There is wifi connection.

The use of the work / rehearsal room is also included. It is shared with the center's activities. The room has 60m² with a central column, wooden pavement, concrete walls and led spotlight lighting. Artists can also use a video projector and a stereo system. An accompaniment to artists is planned according to their needs: contacts with the community, other artists, services and suppliers, etc.

Fees

The artists are co-responsible for the maintenance of the residence and therefore pay a fee according to the number of residents and guests and the length of each residency:

- 1 resident € 5 per day
- 2 residents € 10 per day
- 3 or 4 residents € 20 per day

This fee, which must also be paid by relatives and guests of the residents, must be transferred to the Nau Còclea account at the time of being selected and accepting residence.

The artist must arrive at the residence by his own means. Travel or living expenses and medical assistance insurance are not covered. Artists not resident in the Spanish state must have health insurance during the stay.

Submission of applications

Applications can be submitted until February 9, 2020. The list of selected artists will be published on February 24, 2020.

Artists should send a document (PDF or Word) by email to resident@naucoclea.com. The document and the email subject must include the name of the project manager.

The request must include the following:

- * Contact information of the project manager: name, email and telephone.
- * Number of members staying in the residence up to a maximum of 4
- * Preferred dates for residence and alternative options (if any). **If your dates are flexible or if you have alternative options, your request is more likely to be accepted.**
- * A letter in which the artist explicitly agrees to make the residency in the selected period and in accordance with the conditions of this call.
- * Spaces that will be needed (home / work room / outdoor accommodation)
- * A description of the project (maximum 3 pages plus links)
- * A short CV (maximum 1 page) and portfolio or website.

After receiving the request we will send a confirmation letter. You should contact us at resident@naucoclea.com if you have not received the confirmation letter of receipt within 5 days.

Jury and selection process

Residences are granted according to the following criteria:

- * Artistic value of the proposal
- * Consistency and feasibility of the project
- * Relationship of the project with the center's lines of work: performance, sound art, walking art.
- * Potential of the project to be shared with different audiences
